
MIDDLE SCHOOL EXPLORE THE TRADES CAMP

Campers, please read this with your parents/guardians:

If there are any medications or medical issues we should know about, remember to make note of it in the Notes section of your camper registration form.... Very important.

Closed toe shoes are required.

Shoulder length or longer hair MUST be tied back.

Long pants are required.

Shirts with sleeves are required (short sleeves are OK)– no tank tops.

Cell phones are allowed at camp, however, cell phones should be turned off during activity times. Breaks and lunch are when cell phones should be seen. Cell phone distractions will be handled on and individual basis between camper, parent/guardian, and camp advisors.

All Personal Protective Equipment will be provided, however, if the camper has a preferred pair of gloves that fit well, it is ok to bring them. Safety glasses are provided as well, smaller stature campers may find them somewhat uncomfortable, so if you would like to bring your own, please do.

We will be conducting workshops in the direct sunlight at times. A limited resource of sun protection will be available. Please apply sun screen at home before you come to camp and we will have some for reapplication purposes throughout each day.

Please bring a refillable/reusable water bottle. Make sure to clearly mark it with your name for identification purposes. We will be providing hydration stations of iced water to fill them with as the camper desires.

Breakfast & lunch will be provided. It is ok to bring your own food to be eaten at appropriate times.

Remember, this is a summer camp about the construction trades – you will be getting dirty.

Thursday, July 12, is our last day. From 1:30 - 2:30 will be something super fun. Invite your parents/guardians to come enjoy it with us.
