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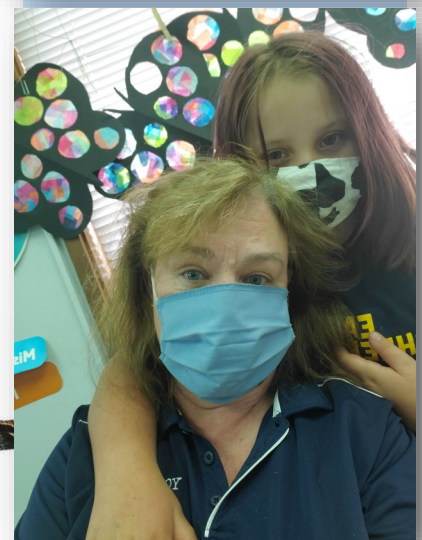
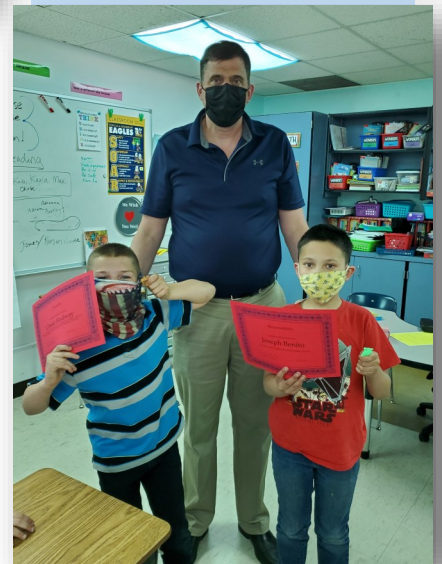
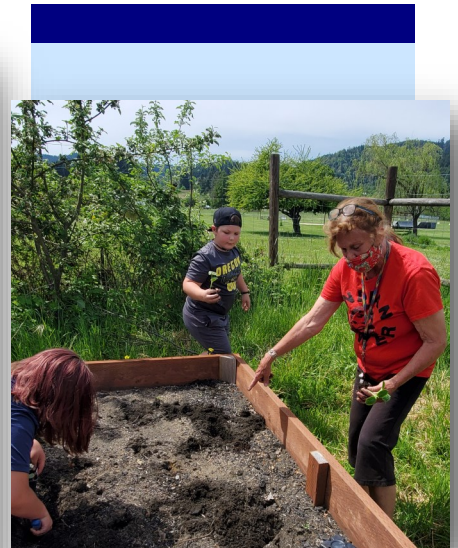




Ms. Shilling's class prepares to release steelhead into a local creek.

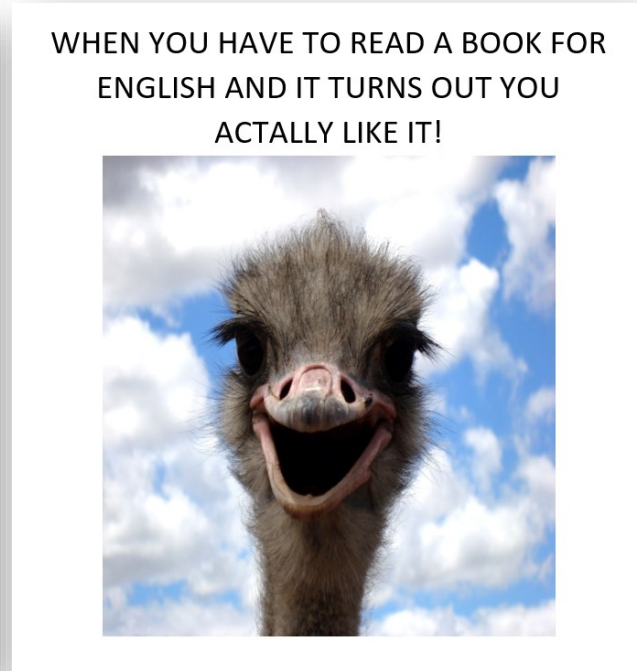
