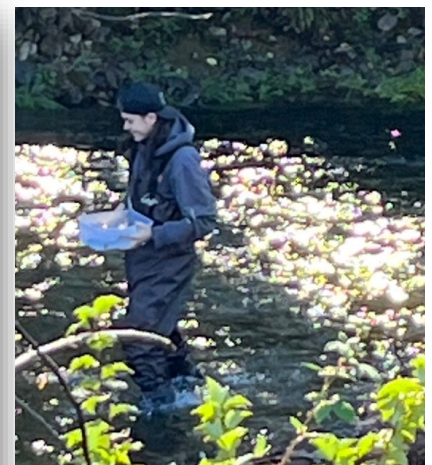

The Second-grade class won the attendance award for September. The class voted on getting ice cream at the deli. It was so good and so fun. We are so proud of them!

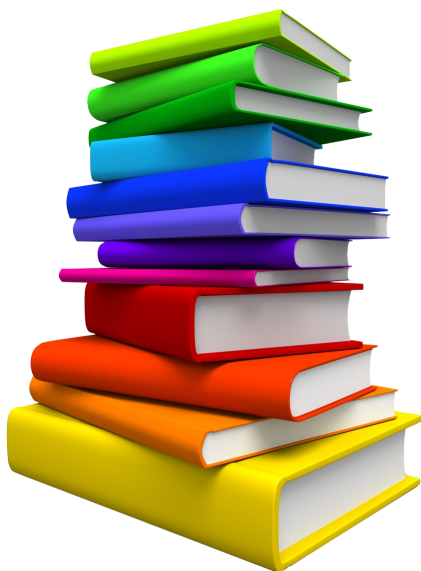

District Priorities

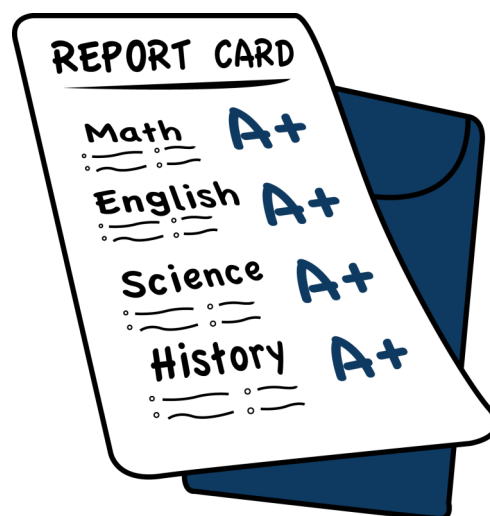
1. Each student will enjoy positive, engaging learning environments.
